(Q) Please tell us something about yourself, what is your name, what do you do?

(A) I'm Dr. Donirung Reang. I completed my Bachelor of Naturopathy Yoga and Science (BNYS) Doctor degree from Chhattisgarh in 2013, Then, I went to Bengaluru for my further PG studies. I did MD(Y&R), Yoga and Rehabilitation course from S-Vyasa Yoga University from 2014 to 2017 Jan. Then, from Feb 2017 onwards, I started working in S-Vyasa University as an Assistant medical officer. After 3 years working in S-Vyasa University, I was offered to serve in social services by Sevabharati Purbanchal Guwahati, Assam. Then, I resigned my job from S-Vyasa University. Now, from July 2019, I am working with Sevabharati as Chief Medical officer (CMO).

(Q) Can you tell us a little bit about your life, how it started, what struggles did you face?

(A) Basically I am from Mizoram, due to some issues, we Reang (BRU) tribes has to move to Tripura in 1997, the countrymen called us as Refugee because we were forcefully moved to Tripura from Mizoram, the reason why we moved to Tripura from Mizoram is, our Mizoram Brus demanded ADC, Autonomous District Council. But mizos didn't accept our demand, they burnt our houses, our many sisters got raped and we are tortured by mizos. Though we are the residence of Mizoram, we don't have freedom for studies, we don't have freedom to worship God of our Hindus rituals. My parent's grand father's were beaten up by our local mizos. Like this, we were facing many problems in Mizoram. I was in 3rd standard during 1997, all our Reang Brus were leaving Mizoram with their luggage by walking. There were no vehicle to move from Mizoram to Assam, so all children's, old everybody has to walk, as I was too young I couldn't understand why people are moving suddenly. That day evening it was my last day of school in Mizoram. I could see many people walking on the road from my school, at 4PM we came back home from school, when I reached my home our luggage were also packed ready, I started crying saying that what will happen when we leave the village my

education will be stopped. So, myself, my elder brother and my younger sister we were three brothers and sisters, has to move following our parents. It was July 1997, we left Mizoram by walking day and night through the forest sometimes we crossed many small rivers to reach Assam. In Assam we have many known person or families members from my grand father's side also grand mother side, so after 2 days of walking we could reach Cachar Assam, a small Reang village called Riflemara in Hailakandi district. we stayed there for 3 months. Then, I got a good news from my father, that I was selected to study in Darchawi high school which is in Tripura. So myself and my elder brother Dhananjay Reang were taken to Tripura with 5 more students from Raiflemara village. We walked throughout the day

taking our luggage. We had to climb many high mountains and need to cross rivers. Even though we were tired, I was feeling so happy inside because my education is going to start again after a very bleak future when I was forced to leave the Mizoram school. After walking whole day, finally we reached that part of Tripura which is very near to Kanhmun Mizoram. From Kanhmun to Damchera, there was only one bridge left to be crossed to reach our hostel but it was very far from the place we were and we decided to stay in one of our uncle's house, who happens to be an officer from Assam. Next day, we got a vehicle to travel to Darchawi hostel. I got admission to 4th standard after clearing my vocal exam. Our principal was too happy with my answers so, instead of making me sit in 3rd standard he asked me to join 4th standard directly. After my successful admission, my father went back to Assam to bring my family members to Naisingpara, Tripura. Here we have 6-7 different camps where our Mizoram friends are settled. My parents too got settled here. Many people died due to unhygienic food and lack of drinking water. When this news reached our Kalyan Ashram Karyakartas like Shri Krishna da Bhide ji and Shri Sanjay Kulkarni ji, they started helping our people. They arranged rice and other daily requirements for the survival of our people.

I completed my education 4th and 5th standard. Then, I came back to my parents who are staying in the Relief camp in Naisingpara. We got vacation for one month. After one month, when I was about to go back to my hostel, there was some fight among some Bengalis and they have blocked the route through which I used to go to hostel. So, I couldn't go to my hostel and I had to discontinue my education. Again, I was worried about my future. One day, my uncle who was working in Kalyan Ashram, he came to my home and asked me whether am I interested to study in Madhya Pradesh. But it was on one condition, that I need to stay continuously in Hostel for 5 complete years without any vacation. By hearing this, my mother started crying saying how can I stay without my daughter for such a long duration? but without thinking twice, I said "yes" "I am ready", "Even 10 years also I can stay", afterwards our journey date was finalized. Myself and 4 more students were selected for hostel, we proceeded to Madhya Pradesh with one of the Karyakarta Shri Krishna da Bhide ji who is continuously serving our northeastern people. I was not knowing how to read and write Hindi that time. After 4 days of long journey, we reached, Shabri Kanya Chhatravas in Raipur, on 16th June 2000. This day happens to be my golden day of my life. Shabri Kanya Chhatravas is situated in Rohinipuram Kanchari Ganga phase II behind Ayurvedic Medical College. We

got our school admission in July. Shabri Ashram is mainly for our Northeastern girls students and had some Chhattisgarh students also. So, we are about total 75 students from all over the North East. This had students in hostel from 1st standard to college. We stayed like one family. We used to do Pratahasmaran, Sandhya bhajan, Samity Shakha everyday along with our regular school. Our hostel was very disciplined. I never felt, that I am alone, staying away from my parents. We used to communicate to our parents by sending letters. We also used to get calls from our parents through landline phone, once in a month or sometimes once in 2-3 months but education was my first priority. So, I studied very hard. Because the medium was Hindi. I had to put in more study hours. Our Kalyan Ashram Karyakartas loved our students. We used to go to different schools from our hostel. My school was 4KM away from my hostel, daily we used to walk 8KM up & down except Sunday. My school was Maa Sharda Vidhya Mandir. In 6th standard, I could pass with first division around 72%. From 7th standard onwards, I got 1st position in my class till 9th. Sanskrit was very difficult for me to write and pronounce. After that I was continuously in 1st. We got vacation after our 9th standard completion. We all went home after 4 years of staying away from parents. After 10th standard completion, I changed my school to Mayaram Surjan Higher Secondary school in Raipur and took Biology as my subject. I completed my 11th and 12th with a good marks but not it was not satisfactory because mine was a government school. Teachers hardly used to come to my class, to teach us. So, my knowledge was poor. As we were from Kalyan Ashram, there was no facilities for coaching. So, I had to do self study. Only one teacher used to come to our hostel to teach math subject. But, I could complete my 12th with first division. During the same time, I also had the responsibility of looking after hostel students who were sick. I used to take them to hospital. I used to give medicine to sick students. Sometimes, I missed my school too. Our hostel incharge was Smt Madhuvi Joshi the very famous Akhil Bharatiya Mahila Pramukh and her husband Nishikant Joshi ji. When I was in 11th standard, Madhuvi didi ji and Nishikant bhaiya ji, was transferred to Nagpur. So, in place of them, Vaishali didi and Dinkar Deshpande ji, got transferred to our hostel from Maharashtra. After completion of 12th exam again, we had vacation. So we came home for one and half months. During my holidays, Dinkar Deshpande bhaiya ji filled my admissions form for PMT Pre Medical Test exam in Ayush system of medicine. I was not informed about the admission. Got to know that I have to take up PMT exam only after vacation. I was so nervous thinking of my exam. I was not mentally prepared for exam but the

exam date was very near, but I just read my book of Biology, physics and chemistry subject and just I went and wrote my exams. I was selected with a very good rank in Chhattisgarh, but my parents couldn't afford my education. But because of Dinkar Deshpande bhaiya ji efforts, I got admission to my Naturopathy college in Durg Nagpura, called Mahavir Medical College of Naturopathy in Yogic Science. I didn't have any knowledge about Naturopathy and Yoga. Sometimes, I used to be worried about my degree course because during those days very few people knew about Naturopathy degree but Deshpande bhaiya ji stood with me every time. They both were like my parents in the unknown place. They put huge efforts for my education. Bhaiya ji use to collect donations for my education, some time he was insulted sometimes he was appreciated. All those situations, are very hard to explain in words. How they used to feel for me even though they were not related to me. They loved me so much. I know, God is with those who ever doesn't have money, with poor people or who doesn't have parents. So, they are like a gift from God for me. When I was in 2 year of BNYS my elder brother passed away but I couldn't meet him for the last time. I faced many sad situation. My father use to suffer from many diseases at home but still he insisted me to study, making my future, I was busy with my bright future but again during my final Exam my mother also passed away. So I had to complete my education with tears. but what to do there were no other option. After my final Exam, I went home for my mother tithi, the villagers said I'm heartless girl, emotionless girl, because I was not there at home during my brother and mother death. I still had my Internship pending to get my degree. I was wondering weather to go for internship or stay back home and help my father. But my father knew very well that if I don't complete my last year, there is no value to all the effort I had put so far. So, finally I listened to my inner voice and my father. I booked my train tickets for Pune Maharashtra for Internship in NIN National Institute of Naturopathy. I did my internship for 3 months. after that, another 3 months in Urulikanchan Maharashtra. Then, I came back to my college in Chhattisgarh. Here I did my internship for 6 months in November. I got my degree. Again one more opportunity was waiting for me. Shri. Girish ji Kuber asked me for my PG but I was not mentally prepared because of financial issues. I wanted to search for a job and help my father. But future had something else in store for me. After all, I got permission from my father too to do my PG. so I went to Bangalore for further studies. There, I met Nagbhushan ji who arranged my college and education. During my stay in Chhattisgarh, Bangalore was my dream city. I got admission for my

MD in S-Vyasa University with the help of Nagbhushan ji and Kuber bhaiya ji, I was so happy with the subject of Bhagavad Gita and Vedas Upanishads in S-Vyasa University, my life was totally changed. With all sad stories, I continued my education, my first semester was about to complete and exams were also completed but my college fees for that semester was 50k but due to financial issues I couldn't pay my fees. Kuber bhaiya ji one day called me to ask the exact amount to be sent for my fees, and I called my coordinator sir Dr. Ashwin Bilagi, he said don't worry, your fees is already cleared by one of the donor. I told Kuber bhaiya ji my fees is already paid bhaiya ji, he was also shocked that he has not sent money and how come the fees was paid. I cried with happiness and giving thanks to almighty God. I didn't have bank account also. I asked my coordinator sir whenever I needed any help. In Second semester 2015, I got selected for Germany for research project, but I didn't have Passport and also worried about my financial status. All these situations created conflict in my mind, weather to go or not to go. But our CMO Dr. R. Nagaratna, said I must go to Germany, so again I asked permission to Girish ji Kuber bhaiya ji about my condition, he said you must go beta, we are very proud of you, now I got more confidence so I started applying for passports and it was successfully completed within 3 months. During those 3 months I was doing Internship in NIMHANS hospital in Bangalore. When my Visa was ready and in the month of September 2015 which also happens to be my birthday i.e 7th September I flew to Germany through Qatar Airways before that I have never been on any flight journey. This was the first in flight that also direct to Germany. I couldn't explain how my mind and heart says thanks to kalyan ashram because each and every bit of my life today is because of kalyan ashram. I was there in Germany for 3 months, after 3 months I came back to my Mother land. I completed my 3 years of MD in Yoga on 2017 January. Then, I was offered to work in my University so I worked for 3 years continuously and then on 2019 July I joined Sevabharati Purbanchal Guwahati Assam.

(Q) What has been the role of Vanavasi Kalyana in your life?

(A) Kalyan ashram has not only helped me but many other country men who are in need but many students don't understand the views and the purpose of Kalyan ashram work. So many people don't complete their education. They leave their education in between. Many of them they could not afford for their higher education after leaving kalyan ashram.

(Q) If it wasn't for Vanavasi Kalyana, how do you think your life would have been different?

(A) My only message to other students who are staying in kalyan ashram hostel will be, just follow the rules and regulations of hostel, be punctual and obedient, be patience. Whatever the situation may be, never give up. Stay on wherever you are, and support our karyakartas who are selflessly helping you day and night, and most importantly prepare yourself to be with the nation, live for the people from where you are brought up and help the needy people with your knowledge and experience you get from our Sangh Parivar. Thank you so much for choosing me to be one of the girl from ashram Parivar.

जगदेव राम उरांव वनवासियों की आस्था का नाम है। उनके जीवन में संपूर्ण समाज के लिए उनमें 'तू-मैं एक रक्त' का भाव है। वे अत्यंत सहज, सरल, विनम्र, मृदुभाषी, संत हृदय, तपस्वी स्वभाव के वनवासी कर्मयोगी थे। वनवासी धर्म-संस्कृति ही भारतीय धर्म-संस्कृति है इसलिए भारतीय धर्म-संस्कृति को संरक्षित एवं अक्षुण्ण बनाये रखना पड़ेगा। जनजातियों की धर्म-संस्कृति-परंपरा हमारे जगदेव राम के समुद्र सा विशाल हृदय में, गगनचुंबी पर्वत के समान ऊंचे विचारों में एवं सर्व स्पर्शी-सर्वव्यापी धाराप्रवाह पवन से पवित्र चिंतन में समाहित था। वे कथनी-करनी, सोच-विचार, चिंतन-मनन के समन्वय को आत्मसात कर समाज के पथ प्रदर्शक एवं युग द्रष्टा बन गए। जगदेव राम उरांव जी उरांव जनजाति के आस्था के केंद्र रोहतासगढ़ को पुनर्जागरण कर देश-विदेश के संपूर्ण वनवासियों को एक सूत्र में स्थापित कर गए।

शबरी कुंभ, नर्मदा कुंभ, उज्जैन का अर्ध कुंभ, देशभर के वनवासी सम्मेलनों में उनका मार्गदर्शन वनवासी समाज के लिए स्मरणीय रहेगा। जगदेव राम जी ने संपूर्ण देश के विकास हेतु उत्तर-पूर्व जैसे कठिन एवं दुर्गम क्षेत्रों में प्रवास कर वहां के सामाजिक,



धार्मिक व सांस्कृतिक समस्याओं के समाधान हेतु कार्यकर्ताओं का मार्गदर्शन किया है। वे कहा करते थे वनवासी नवीन युवक-युवतियों को कार्य से जोड़ना, उनका व्यक्तित्व विकास करना जिससे वे स्वयं वनवासी समाज का नेतृत्व कर सकें। सभी जनजातियों में एवं सभी जनजाति गांवों में कार्य को बढ़ाना जिससे वनवासी समाज स्वाभिमान पूर्वक देश दुनिया के सामने खड़ा हो सके। वे कहते थे मैं स्पष्ट देख रहा

हूँ कि भारतीय संस्कृति का प्रादुर्भाव अरण्य क्षेत्रों में, वनों से प्रभावित होकर जंगलों, पहाड़ों सभी जगह पहुंच रही है, कोई भी क्षेत्र अब रिक्त नहीं रहेगा। क्रीडा, शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, ग्राम विकास से कोई भी वनवासी क्षेत्र अछूता नहीं रहेगा और पूरा देश समरसता और एकात्म भाव के साथ एकरस होकर अरण्य निवासिनी भारत माता को विश्व के सिंहासन पर पुनः स्थापित करेगा। क्षेत्र में कार्य करने

वाले सम विचारी संगठनों संस्थाओं एवं जनजाति बिरादरी के संगठनों से समन्वय स्थापित कर उनके एवं अपने कार्यों के माध्यम से वनवासी समाज को आत्मनिर्भर बना सके, ऐसा कार्य भी करना है। सभी आयामों का कार्य विस्तार, प्रकल्पों का गुणात्मक विकास अच्छा हो इस हेतु कार्यकर्ताओं का प्रवास नियमित और व्यवस्थित रहे।

जनजाति समाज के प्रति उनकी निष्ठा, प्रतिष्ठा, तपस्या, समर्पणशील स्वभाव हमेशा देश को याद रहेगा, उनके प्रेरक विचार वनवासी समाज के सर्वांगीण विकास करने में हमें प्रेरणा देते रहेंगे जिससे हम सभी कार्यकर्ताओं को निरंतर प्रवाहमान बने रहने में प्रेरणादायी एवं उपयोगी सिद्ध होंगे।

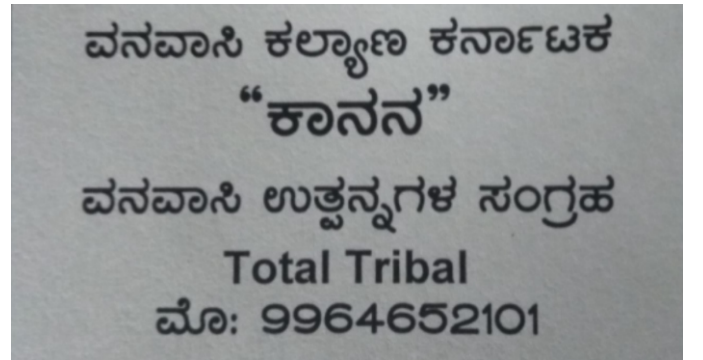

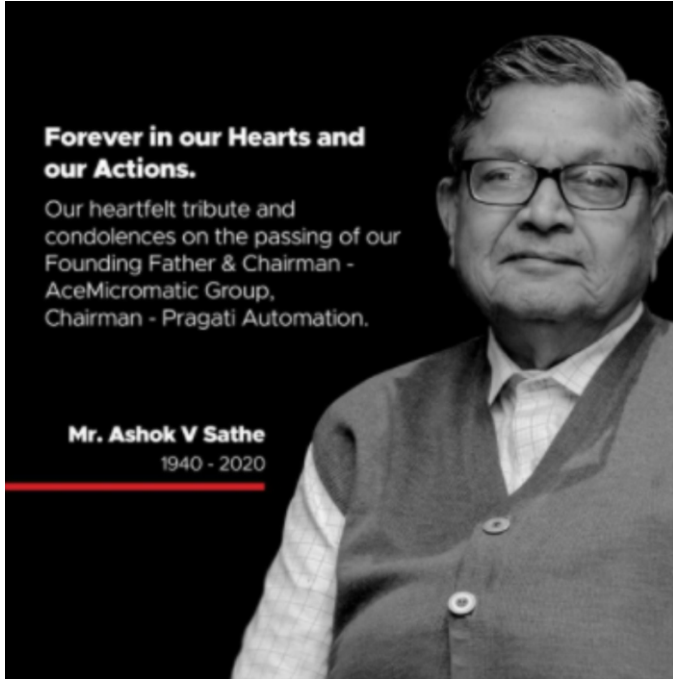
